Rodriguez discussed the Covid case numbers testing and results, with a positivity rate of 3.84% there has been 158 positive, 3,961 negative, 60 pending, 116 recovered, 26 active, and 16 deaths. Schools will be opening soon, they have plans in place for WIU and for the School Districts but he feels that the Health Department should be ramping up efforts. They are still not getting any cooperation from the Health Department as they are only working 4 days a week and he feels that they should be working on a rotation to be available 7 days a week. They had been working 7 days a week, once we went 19 days without any positive case's they went back to 4 days. Member Hiel inquired as to who the Health Department reported to. WIU is working the IDPH to provide mass testing.
