- ► For a dog you must get a rabies shot from a veterinarian within 10 days of adoption date and register with the McDonough County Treasurer's Office, #1 Courthouse Square, Macomb, IL 61455. Telephone: (309-833-2032). If animal, whether cat or dog, is unfixed then must get spayed or neutered with 30 days or the date specified on front of adoption contract to be in compliance with the law. Must contact Animal Shelter when vaccination and/or spay/neutering is complete with proof.
- ► Arrange for spay/neuter, if not already done. *This is part of your contract agreement.*
- ▶ <u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> the contract voucher covers anesthesia and surgery **ONLY**. Anything additional (pain medications, vaccines, de-worming, blood work, etc is <u>NOT</u> covered by the voucher.
